

Members of our Santa Ynez Community & Fellow Horse People:

We as a horse community are blessed to be able to call the Santa Ynez Valley home, and we are so fortunate to have the beautiful Santa Ynez Valley Equestrian Center as a base for our community equestrian activities. Dedicated, quality, affordable and publically available equestrian event venues are scarce in California and becoming scarcer all the time.

2024 is going to be an exciting year at the Santa Ynez Valley Equestrian Center. In addition to our 2nd annual **Ranch Cutting-SortNRope**, slated for November, we are thrilled to be hosting our 1st ever **Santa Ynez Cutting Series**. Turnout and support for our November 2023 Ranch Cutting/SortNRope was outstanding, and the primary feedback was "we loved this! When is your next event?" Ask & ye shall receive: Our 1st **SYV Cutting** will be **April 13-14**th with our 2nd date scheduled for early June. We will feature high quality western theme vendors and have food available, so bring your family and enjoy watching talented cutting horses in action!

Please consider supporting our Cutting Series as a sponsor this year. All funds raised beyond our event expenses will directly support maintaining & improving our facility. The SYVEA is a volunteer-run non-profit 501[c]3 organization with no

salaried employees. Our member-supported 28 acre multi-disciplinary facility provides home arenas for those in our community who do not own their own arena or keep horses at professional training facilities, as well as those who simply want to ride and school in a large arena with excellent footing. We are the home of **SYV Therapeutic Riding** as well as the **Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Posse** and support Youth equestrian events throughout the year. Additional events include regular **VPA Sorting-Pennings**, the **Ranchero Maverick Roping** and specialty equine clinics as well as **On The Bit Dressage schooling shows**.

Our operating cash needs are partially funded by our affordably priced membership fees [averaging \$30,000/year] as well as facility event rentals [averaging \$16,000/year.] We maintain a fiscally responsible savings account for emergency needs such as well repairs & storm damage, however we depend upon donations and community support of our events to fund infrastructure repair & improvements.

Our current pressing needs include: Arena footing refurbishment [\$20,000+], a new /newer used water truck [\$50,000-\$150,000], overnight event pens [also useful for emergency evacuations-- we already have the donated pipe & panels to start them] and new roofs on both our upper barns [\$50-60,000.] We raised \$31,000 in November, which was a great start, but obviously there is a long way to go. From November 2023 through January 2024, we have repaired the cattle handling pens, partially refurbished the Cow Horse Arena footing and erected 14 temporary overnight pens.

We are excited to bring Cutting events to Santa Ynez and would very much appreciate your support!
